AFRICAN DRUG AND ALCOHOL AWARENESS PROJECT & TRAINING (ADAAPT) PROVIDES A NUMBER OF CONFIDENTIAL SERVICES FOR AFRICAN PEOPLE TO RAISE AWARENESS ON DRUG AND ALCOHOL RELATED PROBLEMS

TRAINING

Training parents and young people as peer educators and community interactors to increase awareness on drug, alcohol and substance misuse among the African Community.

ADVICE

Drop-in services on a one to one basis is provided to offer advice and is confidential.

DRUG AWARENESS SESSIONS

Organise workshops and awareness sessions for adults and young people. This is to enable them support each other, socialise and discuss matters and issues relating to drugs, alcohol and substance misuse, within the African communities.

ONE-TO-ONE WORK

Provision of free and confidential one-to-one service for adults and young people.

OUTREACH

An opportunity for community members to have an informal setting to discuss and address drug issues in their own environment and distribution of information.

LINK & REFERRAL TO TREATMENT SERVICES

Networking with other service providers and referrals are made to support and help people with the problem of drugs, alcohol and substance misuse to access treatment services.

SELF SUPPORT SYSTEMS

Provide assistance and support to individuals and community members to develop skills that enable them to get solutions to drug and alcohol related problems.
